(a) Purposes of Collection of Personal Data

The personal data provided in (and in support of) this application by you or by any other persons may be used and held by the Company for one or more of the following:

- (i) to administer and/or enforce the provisions of any relevant ordinances (including the Insurance Ordinance (Cap. 41 of the Laws of Hong Kong) (the “Ordinance”)) and any regulations;
- (ii) to process any application(s) you may make to or received by the Company;
- (iii) to monitor your fitness and properness and your status to remain licensed or approved (as the case may be) under the Ordinance;
- (iv) to investigate complaints and handle enquiries;
- (v) to co-operate with and assist any other regulatory body and/or law enforcement body of Hong Kong SAR, or of any place outside Hong Kong SAR, whenever appropriate, and to the extent permitted by the laws of Hong Kong SAR;
- (vi) for any statistical and/or research purposes; or
- (vii) other purposes directly relating to any of the above or as permitted by the laws of Hong Kong SAR.

Unless indicated otherwise provision of the requested personal data is compulsory. Failure to supply the required personal data may result in the Company not being able to process your application. In addition, you have the duty to inform the Company of any changes in your personal data held by the Company.

(b) Transfer of Personal Data

Personal data will be kept confidential but, subject to the provisions of any applicable law, may be transferred within and outside of Hong Kong SAR, and:

- (i) Made available to appropriate persons in our parent, subsidiaries and affiliated companies, local and overseas;
- (ii) Supplied to any agent, contractor or third party who provides administrative or other services to any group company in Hong Kong SAR or elsewhere and who has a duty of confidentiality to us; examples of such persons: external auditors, lawyers, medical practitioners, trustees, insurance companies, actuaries, bankers and any consultants/agents appointed by any group company to conduct any research and/or data analysis;
- (iii) Supplied with your consent; or
- (iv) Disclosed to any government departments or other appropriate governmental or regulatory authorities in Hong Kong SAR or elsewhere such as the Inland Revenue Department, Securities and Futures Commission and the Hong Kong Monetary Authority, the Travel Agents Registry, the Travel Industry Council of Hong Kong, law enforcement agencies, law courts, tribunals and committees.

Transfer of your personal data will only be made for one or more of the purposes specified above.

(c) Access and correction of Personal Data

Under the PDPO, you have the right to ascertain whether the Company holds your personal data, to obtain a copy of the data, and to correct any data that is inaccurate.
