

Notice to Washington, D.C. Insureds

This notice is being sent on behalf of the Chubb Group companies listed below.

Please read this notice carefully.

On April 27, 2020, Commissioner's Order 03-2020, issued by the Washington, D.C., Department of Insurance, Securities, and Banking gave guidance about insurance coverage for businesses that are instituting delivery service as a result of the COVID-19 public health emergency.



Pursuant to that guidance, we are notifying you of the following:

Hired and non-owned automobile coverage is available upon request for Washington, D.C. restaurants who are instituting delivery service as a result of the Public Emergency and Public Health Emergency declared through Mayor's Orders 2020-045 (March 11, 2020) and 2020-052 (March 23, 2020). The coverage shall be effective upon the date it is requested and applies to restaurants with a commercial general liability policy in effect on or after March 17, 2020. Retroactive coverage back to March 17, 2020 also may be requested, providing that you certify that you have not incurred any potential claims during the period of retroactive coverage.

The Commissioner's Order 03-20 will remain in effect through the duration of the Public Health Emergency, including any extensions. All other terms and conditions of your policy remain the same. Please contact your agent if you are interested in this coverage.
